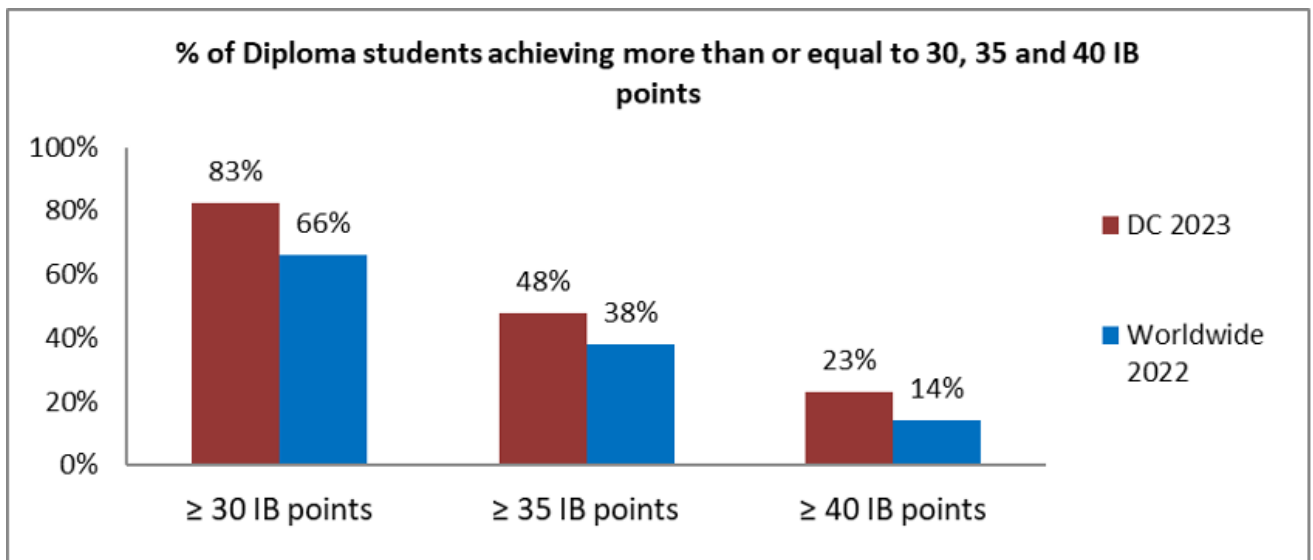
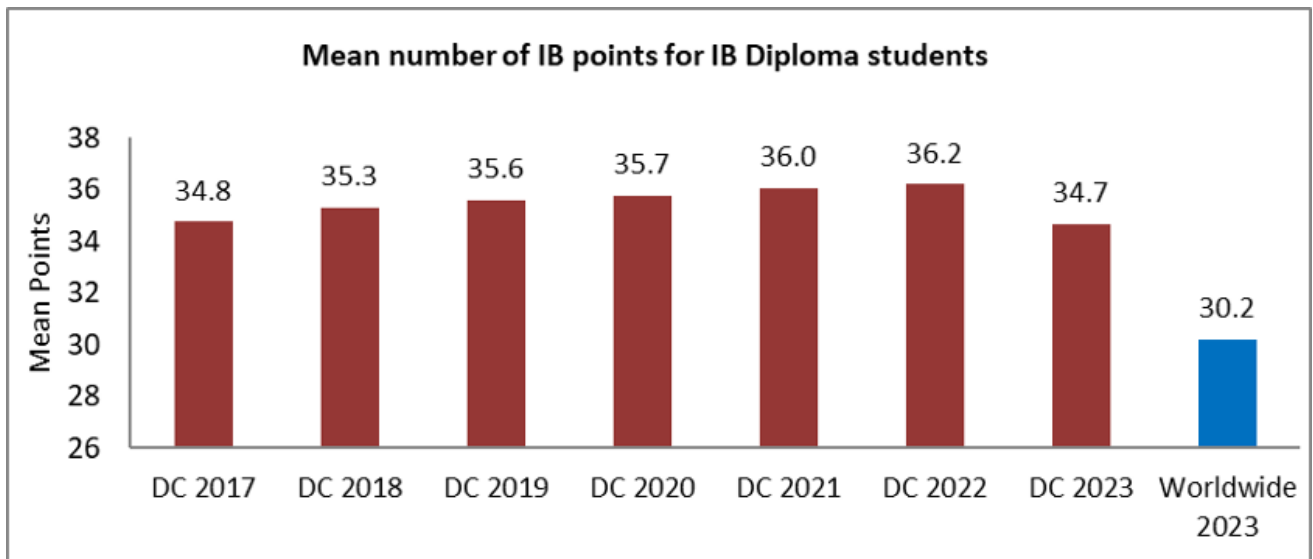




## IB Diploma Provisional Results: May 2023 - Discovery College

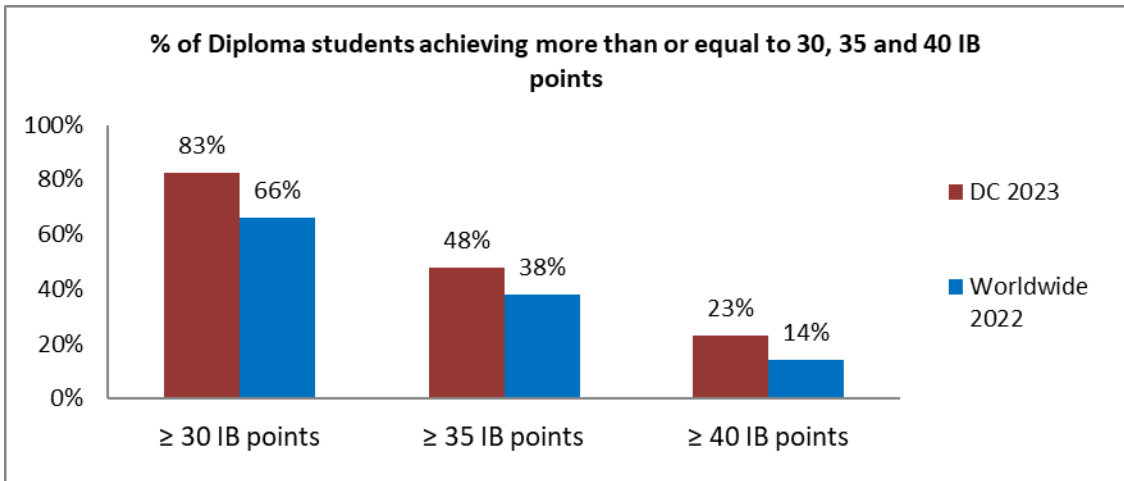
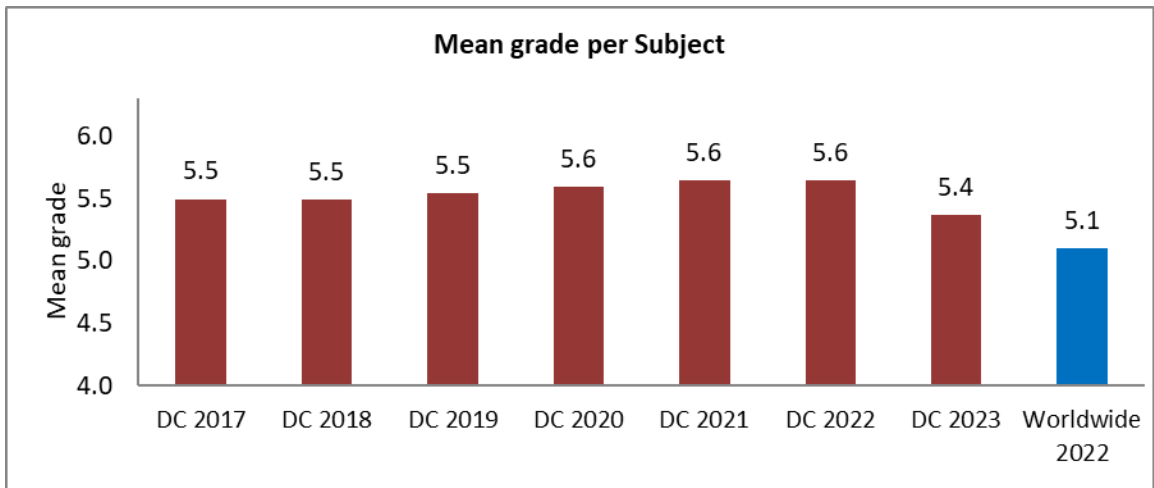
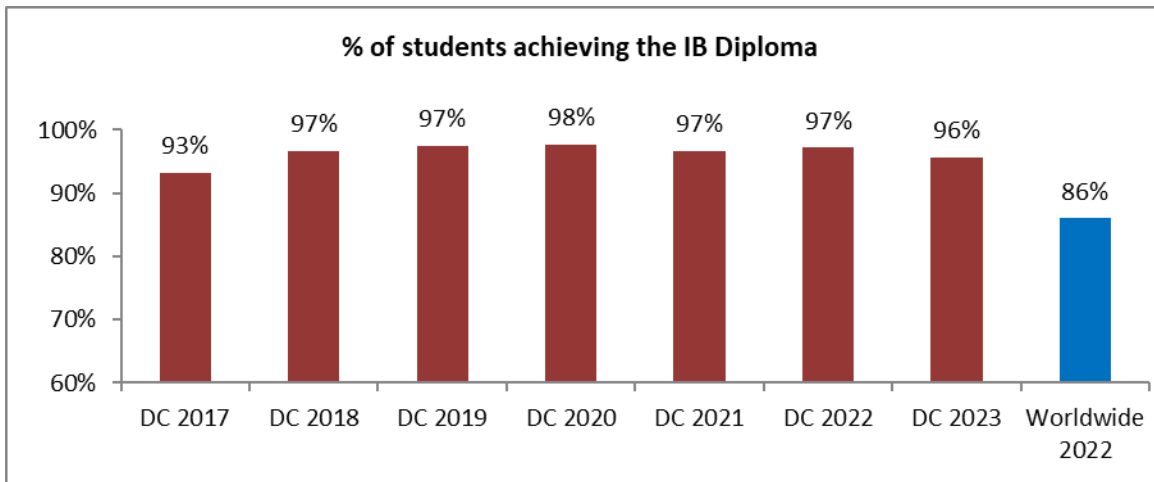
